ONLINE GOSPEL CAMPAIGNS MAKE HISTORY

During the government lockdowns, through sponsorship of World Impact Ministries, we were able to conduct gospel campaigns to unreached language groups on social media. Each campaign involved six days of outreach with a gospel sermon, testimonies from people whose lives have been changed by Jesus, and an invitation to receive Christ, follow up and pray for the sick. 34,457,059 people participated in a full campaign!



GOSPEL TRAINING DURING THE CIVIL WAR

In addition to the lockdowns, a military coup has brought the country of Myanmar to civil war in 2021. Still, our school operated strong and students helped people with practical needs and preached the gospel. In order to ensure the safety of students, we were able to obtain a secure campus for the World Impact Bible Institute in Myanmar. Kway Lin, director of the school, stated,

"These facilities allow students to continue their studies safely, even in the midst of political turmoil in our country. Our previous location was right in the center of much violence and protesting".







In partnership with Scott Mission, TNO Thorncliffe Park, and Second Harvest, we were able to distribute over 48,000 pounds of food to those in need in our community in a time of great crisis. We were able to give away 1,022 pairs of shoes and distribute Christmas socks to an Indigenous community in Northern Canada.





Navigating through lockdowns and regulations, 43 students overcame the challenges and took part in the World Impact Bible Institute Indonesia graduation. "It hasn't been easy, but I'm proud of our staff and students. It's a joy to see so many participating and graduating and ready to impact Indonesia with the gospel", shared Susan Hoover, the head of WIBI Indonesia.

The Stand with Stephen Fund was an initiative with a two-pronged approach, to help Christians who are persecuted for their faith. Within several of the countries, where persecution is strongest, we support Bible schools where the gospel workers are trained. Through the Stand with Stephen Fund, our help increased. The Stand with Steven fund affected changes in government through a strategic partnership with a Global Advocacy Center, which has consultancy status at the United Nations.

If a pastor is killed or a church is bombed, government leaders are rallied to create pressure on regimes that tolerate persecution against Christians. The work engages in the defence of human rights and Christian public engagement. There are beautiful stories of pastors who were in prison but have been released because of this work before the UN Human Rights Council. The Stand with Stephen fund is a partnership with the 1 in 8 Christians who suffer today for their faith in Christ.



World Impact Bible Institutes in East Africa saw 115 students participate in graduation, 53 in Kenya and 62 in Tanzania. Grace Shadrack, who administers WIBI Kenya, shared, "We are so thankful to Dr. Peter Youngren and for his steadfast commitment to training gospel workers in Africa. Students will now embark on their journeys to take the gospel to their communities and beyond."



Yotham & Maria Naingollan, graduates from WIBI in Sumatra, Indonesia moved to Papua, and opened World Impact Bible Institute Papua. Despite the government lockdowns and restrictions, Yotham & Maria were able to recruit and train Gospel workers in this remote area of the globe!



Lionell Daniel, a former graduate of the World Impact Bible Institute here in Canada, now runs an affiliate WIBI school in India. This past year they trained & graduated 12 Gospel workers into the nation of India, which presently ranks 10th on the Open Doors report of countries where Christians are most persecuted for their faith.
