Day 1: January 21

YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

Pray that you would more fully know the riches of your salvation in Christ and that your family would too.

Having the eyes of your hearts enlightened, that you may know what is the hope to which he has called you, what are the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints. — Eph. 1:18

Pray that TICC would shine brighter & brighter as a light of the Gospel to our community.

Pray that we all would have boldness & perseverance to make known the Gospel to our city, nation & world.

DAY 2: January 22

YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

Pray that you and your family will be transformed by the renewal of the mind according to the Word of God.

Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect. — Rom. 12:2

NEIGHBORS, CHURCH, AND COWORKERS

Pray that you and TICC would contend for the faith so that the Gospel may be proclaimed with clarity to your neighbours.

I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints. — Jude 3

YOUR CITY AND NATION

Pray for the knowledge of Christ's love to penetrate every sector of society— family, business, education, media, government, and entertainment—sparking an awakening in our city & country.

THE WORLD AND THE GLOBAL CHURCH

Pray that missionaries and church leaders throughout the world would be delivered from opposition so that they might preach the gospel without hindrance.

Day 3: January 23

YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

Pray that you and your family would know the love of Christ and respond in love and obedience to Him.

To know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. — Eph. 3:19

NEIGHBORS, CHURCH, AND COWORKERS

Pray that the members of your church would be full of zeal to serve Christ and bear witness to Him in your community.

Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord. — Rom. 12:11

YOUR CITY AND NATION

Pray that the leaders of your city and nation would not be antagonistic toward the church but would allow us to freely live godly, peaceful, dignified lives that bear witness to Christ.

I urge that supplications, prayers, intercessions, and thanksgivings be made for all people, for kings and all who are in high positions, that we may lead a peaceful and quiet life, godly and dignified in every way. — 1 Tim. 2:1–2

Pray that people would rise up as missionaries to every tribe and tongue throughout the world.

I looked, and behold, a great multitude that no one could number, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed in white robes, with palm branches in their hands.

Day 4: January 24

YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

Pray that you and your family would be committed to studying, doing, and teaching the Word of Christ, and live awakened lives in Christ.

Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. - Colossians 3:16

NEIGHBORS, CHURCH, AND COWORKERS

Pray that you would be willing to speak Christ's Word to the people in your life and that God would give you boldness to do so.

And now I entrust you to God and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you the inheritance among all those who are sanctified. - Acts 20:32

YOUR CITY AND NATION

Pray for the word of Christ to spread throughout our city & nation.

Finally, brothers and sisters, pray for us that the word of the Lord will spread rapidly and be glorified, just as it was also with you; and that we will be rescued from troublesome and evil people; for not all have the faith. - 2 Thess 3:1-2

Pray that the nations of the world would come to know Christ and call upon His name in faith.

Day 5: January 25

YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

Pray that you and your family would hide Scripture in your heart so that you will be ready to preach the gospel and edify others with God's Word.

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work. - 2 Tim 3:16-17

NEIGHBORS, CHURCH, AND COWORKERS

Pray that you would be filled with boldness and the Holy Spirit, to speak the word of God to those around you.

And when they had prayed, the place where they had gathered together was shaken, and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak the word of God with boldness. - Acts 4:31

YOUR CITY AND NATION

Pray that God would bring the leaders of your city and your nation to faith in Christ.

The king's heart is a stream of water in the hand of the Lord; he turns it wherever he will. — Prov. 21:1

THE WORLD AND THE GLOBAL CHURCH

Pray that the church around the world, especially in countries where it is severely persecuted, would faithfully declare the glory and works of God.

At my first defense no one supported me, but all deserted me; may it not be counted against them. But the Lord stood with me and strengthened me, so that through me the proclamation might be fully accomplished, and that all the Gentiles might hear; and I was rescued out of the lion's mouth. - 2 Tim 4:14-18

Day 6: January 26

YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

Pray that you and your family would trust in the Lord and not in your understanding so that you will walk in the ways of the Lord.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge him, and he will make straight your paths. — Prov. 3:5–6

NEIGHBORS, CHURCH, AND COWORKERS

Pray that God would bless your church with sound teachers who equip people well to minister to others in their neighbourhoods and workplaces.

He gave the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, the shepherds and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ. — Eph. 4:11–12

YOUR CITY AND NATION

Pray that our nation would be turned upside down and changed through the preaching of the gospel.

They dragged Jason and some of the brothers before the city authorities, shouting, “These men who have turned the world upside down have come here also.” — Acts 17:6

Pray that people would rise up who are willing to go to the ends of the earth, to the most out-of-the-way places in order to proclaim the gospel to those who haven’t heard it.

You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth. — Acts 1:8

Day 7: January 27

YOURSELF AND YOUR FAMILY

Pray that you and your family would grow in the grace and knowledge of Christ.

Grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. — 2 Peter 3:18

NEIGHBORS, CHURCH, AND COWORKERS

Pray that your church would be faithful to structure its ministry according to the means of grace—the Word, fellowship, and prayer.

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers.

— Acts 2:42

YOUR CITY AND NATION

Pray that your city would not throw up obstacles to the spread of the gospel as God grants boldness to believers to proclaim His Word.

Now, Lord, look upon their threats and grant to your servants to continue to speak your word with all boldness. — Acts 4:29

THE WORLD AND THE GLOBAL CHURCH

Pray that God would richly bless the church around the world so that unbelievers will see His saving power and be drawn to trust in Him.

And God is able to bless you abundantly, so that in all things at all times, having all that you need, you will abound in every good work. - 2 Cor 9:8
